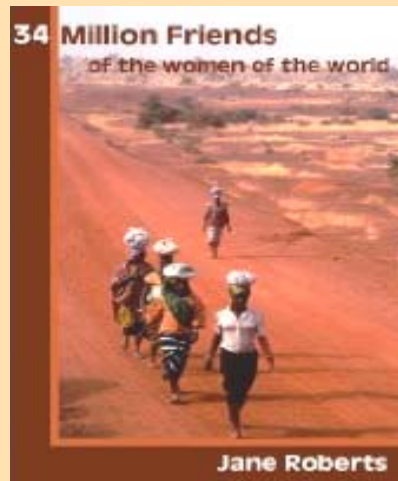

*34 Million Friends of the United Nations
Population Fund: A grassroots
movement for the women of the world*



Jane Roberts and Lois Abraham established 34 Million Friends of UNFPA in 2002 when the Bush Administration first announced they would withhold the \$34 million that Congress allocated to UNFPA. Today the total amount of blocked funds stands at over \$200 million. The idea behind this project is to ask 34 million Americans to donate at least \$1 and in turn, send a message that Americans support UNFPA. UNFPA helps the most vulnerable women in the world plan their families, give birth safely, and protect themselves from HIV/AIDS. It promotes the rights of women by encouraging equal access to food, education, and healthcare. UNFPA works worldwide to eliminate gender-based violence including female genital cutting and rape used as a weapon of war.
